Final Instructions

Thank you for your entry on the event.

Your provisional start number is as per entry list at

Your Start Time at MC0 is 21:45 plus your competition number. All competitors will receive route handouts at this control in numerical order.

Please report to Noise Check at M.R. **395 346.50 (w3w///cried.equipping.licks)** as per enclosed diagram.

After Noise Check, proceed to Scrutineering (**w3w///into.rucksack.freezers**) as shown on the enclosed map.

Fuel is available at Glan Don Service Station, Pwllheli. Please fill up before going to the Start Venue, as once you are parked up you will not be allowed to move your vehicle. There will be super unleaded at petrol halt.

Noise Check will open at **17:00** and close at **19:30**. If you should encounter any unforeseen problems en-route that may delay your arrival, please inform **Mari Lois 07986 987530**.

On successfully completing Noise Check you will receive a Process Card before proceeding to Scrutineering.

After being successfully checked at Scrutineering you will proceed to the start car park at Plas Heli, Pwllheli. Signing-on is at M.R. **383 348.50 (w3w///roughness.lungs.covertly)**

Proceed to marshal signing-on. Make sure your marshal has signed on in order for the Chief Marshal to sign your Process Card. You will then proceed to Map Check and pick up your Competitor Pack. Although you should have signed on electronically, you are also required to sign on in-person.

We also need you to complete the insurance declaration (copy of Declaration is attached to the email. You can complete prior but we will have copies on signing on).

Remember - NO MARSHAL NO START!

If you are under 18 years of age and win an award and need to have your photo taken, a Parental Consent Form must be completed and handed in at signing on. You must complete a Parental Consent Form and hand it in on the night.

AMENDMENTS OR ADDITIONS TO A.S.R's

ASR 8. Officials:

ARS 12. DSO Offence:

“Waving” or placing your hands outside of the car window at spectator points - Disqualification

Any other offence deemed to bring motorsport into disrepute - Disqualification

ASR 17. Damage declaration forms must be handed in at the completion of the event. In the event of a non-finish, where it is not practical to visit the finish venue, forms must be passed on to the event secretary by Tuesday 24th March 2026. Even though you are all using your own insurance, we need to know of any incidents no matter how small. We can also help deal with any repairs swiftly which will ensure we get to keep these roads for future rallies.

If you come across a route that for whatever reason has become impassable, 1st you are required to contact the police control room informing them of the location and detail of the obstruction. 2nd contact the event emergency number provided on the time cards to confirm the re-route to be used. Travel along the given re-route, treat as a quiet zone and drive with spots off. Any time loss will NOT impact results.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DRIVERS MEETING:

A meeting will be held at the signing-on area at **21.20hrs**. **ALL** competitors are required to attend. Any competitor not attending will be disqualified.

MARSHALS:

As stated in the ASR's all competing crews must provide a marshal to cover at least 1 control, and they must sign-on with the competing crew. You are reminded that no Official of the event can be signed-on as a marshal. If a Marshal who has signed-on for a competitor does not turn up at a control or leaves the control area before the arrival of the Closing car, or gets reported for driving in a manner likely to bring motorsport into disrepute, the associated competitor will be Disqualified from the results. The Chief Marshal will issue marshals who are allocated a Time Control with a clock. Should the clock be damaged in any way or go missing then the competitor associated with the marshal will be held responsible. Marshals are asked, if possible, to wear hi-vis clothing at the controls.

MISCELLANEOUS:

The organisers will not enter into argument or discussion regarding the seeding and classes for the event.

You are reminded that the event takes place on public roads, which are not closed. You should drive with consideration to other road users, and remember that you are bound by the Road Traffic Act at all times, any competitor or his associated marshal caught by the Police or an event official breaking the law, will be disqualified from the results and also reported to MSUK for possible further action. Please pay attention to your speed and driving manner at all times.

For the ones having issues with getting their MSUK Competition licences you **MUST** make sure that you have a form which you can hand in at Signing-on on the night, fully completed together with a cheque or your card details on the form in an envelope with a stamp. We will not have any forms printed. It is your responsibility to make sure that you have a 2026 Licence or an application form. The Club will not be held responsible.

We **will not** accept cash for the MSUK licences. Stage Competition Licences application or Stage renewal forms **cannot** be accepted at Signing-on.

We are not accepting cash payments on the night. You need to ensure that you have paid for your membership. If you need a club membership please complete this form [Cais Ymaelodi 2026 Membership application 2026](#) by Friday 10pm.
