CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for Club Championship points, an individual must be a fully paid up member of Harlech and District Motor Club Ltd.

QUALIFYING EVENTS

Qualifying events will be specified for each individual award (see below)

CHAMPIONSHIP TERM

The championship will run annually from 1st January to 31st December.

CLAIMING POINTS

Points cannot be awarded retrospectively for events where the individual was not a member at that time.

Points will be awarded automatically for all competitors of Harlech and District Motor Club events.

For all other events, members must submit their results via the electronic form on the Harlech and District Motor Club website *within 30 days of the event*.

All marshalling points claims must be submitted via the electronic form on the Harlech and District Motor Club website *within 30 days of the event*.

The Championship Coordinator reserves the right to request proof of results from members.

Wherever possible, interim results updates will periodically be provided during the championship term.

Interim results shall remain provisional at all times. Final results will be published no later than 31st January.

SCORING

All Competitive Championships (Road Rally/ Targa/Stages)

1st Overall – 20 points

2nd Overall – 18 points

3rd Overall – 15 points

Overall points scorers (as above) will not be eligible for class points.

1st in Class – 10 points, 2nd in Class – 9 points, down to 8th in Class – 3 points.

All other class finishers score two points.

Non-Finishers score one point.

If an event amalgamates classes, then the amalgamated class structure shall be used to score points.

Dual permit events shall be scored separately, as individual events.

Named officials on a Harlech and District Motor Club event will be awarded 15 points, in the discipline of the event (max two claims per year)

Signed on marshals on a Harlech and District organized event will be awarded 10 points, in the discipline of the event (max two claims per year)

Navigation Runs/Scatters and Table Tops

Championship points will be awarded per event, as follows.

1st – 10 points

2nd – 8 points

3rd 6 points

4th – 5 points

5th 4 points

6th 3 points

7th – 2 points

All finishers – 1 point

4 points per event for organisers

Marshalls

Signed on marshalls will be awarded 2 points for each event.
